If your child is unsure of their email and/or password, assistance can be requested by a Parent/Carer on the school Website. We **cannot** assist with username and/or password issues via Email.

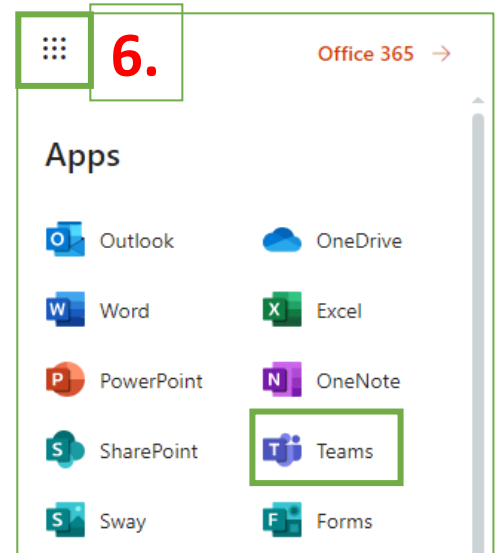

Using Xbox to Access Online Learning

It is possible to access your online work from home using a gaming console. These short tips will show you how.

1. Plug your keyboard into the USB slot on your Xbox
2. Navigate to the ‘My Games and Apps’ section
3. Find ‘Microsoft Edge’ in the Apps section and then open it
4. In the address bar, type in office.com
5. Sign in using your school Office 365 Account email address and password
6. You should now be able to access all the Microsoft suite of apps from the waffle icon in the top left corner including Teams, Word, PowerPoint, Excel etc.

If you have a USB mouse you could also plug this in to navigate around rather than using the controller.



Using PlayStation to Access Online Learning

2. Press the PlayStation logo on the controller and navigate to the Library and then Games and Applications
3. Find the Internet Browser in the Apps section and then open it.
4. In the address bar, type in office.com

6. You should now be able to access all the Microsoft suite of apps from the waffle icon in the top left corner including Teams, Word, PowerPoint, Excel etc.
