

Dear Year 11 Students

Following very significant changes to government policy, we have developed a plan in order to provide you with an opportunity to collect results in person and access a guidance meeting. On Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August we will email you your results as originally planned but we are also opening the school between 8.00 a.m. and midday if you would like to come to school for your results.

You will enter the school via the student entrance, use hand sanitiser available, and make your way to a designated space to collect your results. Once you have your results envelope, you will follow the one-way system to access a guidance meeting should you wish to join the Sixth Form. The guidance meeting is a chance to speak to a member of the sixth form team or one of the subject teachers about your Sixth Form options. If you are not returning to the Sixth Form, you may leave without having a guidance meeting and join staff and other students at the front of the building to celebrate your results.

To confirm your place in the Sixth Form please complete the Confirmation of Place form, remembering to refer to the option blocks and check subject entry requirements. This can be submitted in person on Thursday or e-mailed to [admin@nestonhigh.com](mailto:admin@nestonhigh.com) by 12:00 on Friday 21/8/2020. For students who have narrowly missed the entry requirements one of the Sixth Form team or SLT will be on hand to help out and offer you advice and guidance.

Unfortunately, due to social distancing regulations, we cannot allow your parents/ carers to come into the school building but if they need to speak to a member of staff then they are welcome to phone school and a member of staff will get back to them.
